



Rules of Behavior

The following actions are prohibited on library property:

1. Selling and/or soliciting for services, money or items.
2. Distributing or posting printed materials/ literature that have not been approved by the library, or conducting a survey without permission from library administration.
3. Possessing or consuming alcohol or illegal drugs or being under the influence of such.
4. Smoking or other uses of tobacco, striking matches, or lighting lighters.
5. Consuming food or beverages, including water, in any type of container, or bringing in packaged food or beverages, except for in the public meeting room by an organization that has reserved the room for its use.
6. Sleeping or putting legs, head or feet on the furniture.
7. Not wearing shoes or shirt, or wearing clothes unbuttoned or unzipped.
8. Bringing animals into the library other than assistance animals.
9. Any loud, unreasonable, and or disturbing noises created by persons, or electronic devices.
10. Intentionally damaging, destroying, or stealing library property, or a patron's or library employee's property.
11. Photographing or videotaping without permission of the library administration, and those photographed or videotaped.
12. Removing library materials from the premises, without authorization through established lending procedures.
13. Moving tables, chairs, or other furniture.
14. Blocking entrance or exit to the building.
- 15. Leaving a child aged eight years or younger unattended by an adult.**
16. Misuse of rest rooms, including use of restrooms for bathing or changing of clothes.
17. Carrying weapons of any type.
18. Engaging in disorderly conduct of any kind, fighting, or challenging to fight, or using obscene/offensive words likely to provoke violence.
19. Harassment of patrons or library staff, including, the use of obscene or offensive language.
20. Any behavior disruptive to library operations, including: running in building, throwing objects, using bicycles, skates or skateboards in the building, turning lights off, tampering with fire alarms.
21. Engaging in sexual activity, contact or assault or any act of lewdness or exposure prohibited by New Jersey Statutes Annotated 2C: 14-1 through 2 C: 14-8 and any other sexual activity which is inappropriate to a public place.
22. Engaging in any other illegal activity not otherwise listed.
